28th Annual General Meeting of the Members of Amrit Agro Industries Limited to be held on Tuesday, the 12th August, 2014 at 2.30 P. M. at Chaudhary Bhawan, (Near Jain Mandir), E- Block, Kavi Nagar, Ghaziabad (U. P.) -201 002.

Subject : Passing of resolutions through electronic voting pursuant to section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.

Dear Sir,

1. Pursuant to the resolution passed by the Board of Directors of Amrit Agro Industries Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") on 23rd May, 2014 I have been appointed as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process as mentioned under Rule 20(3)(ix) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.
2. The Company engaged Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) as the Service Provider for extending the facility of electronic voting to the shareholders of the Company. The Service Provider provided a system for recording the votes of the Shareholders electronically on all the items of business (both ordinary and special business) sought to be transacted in the 28th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Company, which is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, the 12th August, 2014. Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) had set up e-voting facility on their website, <https://www.evotingindia.co.in> The Company had uploaded all the items of the business

to be transacted on the website of the Company and also it's Service Provider to facilitate their shareholders to cast their vote through e-voting.

3. As on the cutoff date there were 3592 Shareholders of the Company. The Notice of Annual General Meeting and circular for e-voting was sent to all the Shareholder in Physical Form.
4. The Notice sent in physical form contained the detailed procedure to be followed by the shareholders who were desirous of casting their votes electronically as provided in the Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.
5. The cutoff date (Record date) for the purposes of identifying the Shareholders who will be entitled to vote on the resolutions placed for the approval of the shareholders was 27.06.2014. The e-voting facility was kept open from 6th August, 2014 @9.00 A.M. to 8th August, 2014 @6.00 P.M.
6. Pursuant to Rule 20(3)(v) of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, the Company also released an advertisement, which was published five days in advance from the date of beginning of voting period in Financial Express, English Newspaper and in Jansatta, Hindi Newspaper both dated 17th July, 2014. The notice published in the newspaper carried the required information as specified in the Rule 20(3)(v) (a) to (g).
7. At the end of the voting period on August 8, 2014 at 6.00 P.M. the voting Portal of the service provider was blocked forthwith. On August 8, 2014 The votes vast through e-voting facility was duly unblocked by me as a Scrutinizer in the presence of Shri Shiv Paul Singh and Ms. Shikha Dixit who acted as the witnesses, as prescribed in sub rule 3 (xi) of said Rule 20 of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.
8. Particulars of all Votes cast by electronic mode have been entered in the register separately maintained for the purpose in electronic mode.

As a Scrutinizer the report of the e-voting carried by the shareholders was duly complied, the detail of which are as follows.


